Jenn Clark Re: High School Co op Program.

Co-op itself is a program, and OYAP is any Co-op in an apprenticeable trade. Any of the trades on that linked list may be done Co-op.

Our program also encompasses any number of jobs in the National Occupations Classification Index.

In the context of placements appropriate for jobs linked to TMTA, I have had Co-op students in our program do any number of roles at Truck Coach shops:

Of course, Truck Coach Technician is our go-to for students in the shop.

Our next semester starts at the beginning of February, so students would be prepared to start placements at jobs at end of February or beginning of March.

We offer half day (3 hours-Morning or Afternoon) Partial day (4 hours Morning or Afternoon), and Full Day Co-op (6 hours).

Students are "paid" in credits, and Workers Compensation Insurance Coverage is paid for by the Ministry of Education. (No financial remuneration).

High school students that do a Co-op in a Truck & Coach or Heavy Equipment Shop have a great foundation before starting Conestoga's courses and for working when not in school.

Students receive basic Health and Safety awareness training during the pre-placement phase of the program (start of February), and where appropriate, Working at Heights Training (Acute Environmental Services runs the training for us--we pay for it). Students also receive appropriate PPE for the job (i.e. Steel Toes, Hard Hat, Gloves, Hi-Viz vests, Safety Glasses, etc.).
